Interlink is committed to managing and operating the M5 South West Motorway and its E-way retail business in a safe and responsible manner.

Interlink will at all times treat its employees, contractors, visitors and the general public with due care and respect. The Company will provide a healthy and safe workplace and where reasonably practicable, take actions to identify, evaluate and control those factors in the workplace that cause, or have the potential to cause, injury or ill health.

Interlink is committed to comply with legislative, regulatory and other requirements specific to the business and continuous improvement of Work Health Safety (WHS) management. Interlink will also endeavour for continual improvement in its WHS performance.

To achieve these goals, management will:

- Consult with Workers;
- Maintain awareness of current statutory regulations;
- Provide specific WHS induction training to staff and relevant contractors;
- Prepare a detailed WHS Management Plan (IRM – HR– 001) that will provide the WHS Risk Assessment and control measures, as well as specific and measurable objectives and targets to work towards the elimination of work related injury and illness. This WHS Management Plan is reviewed annually;
- Maintain a WHS committee comprising employees and managers with powers to initiate and follow through on corrective actions.
